#### Overview

After a week of events centered on child rights, in particular on Inclusive Social Protection, what can we take going forward? What are the promising practices that are available and what are the next steps for Inclusive Social Protection. What can we learn from pilot projects on Inclusive Social Protection, how can we scale up these initiatives and what are the stumbling blocks? In particular, what are the UN agencies working on that will continue to advance the Inclusive Social Protection agenda for Member States.

This is a deep dive learning event, as a direct follow up to UN's 2024 Annual Day on the Rights of the Child, and the civil society event *Bridging gaps for Children's Rights and Inclusive Social Protection*.

This event looks at the future of child rights and social protection, with speakers from UN agencies working on social protection along with examples of promising practice from civil society programmes at global, regional and local levels. The event will include a Q&A session and will be live streamed.
